Home/School Support Agreement

By enrolling children at RAF Benson Primary School, parents and children agree to adhere to the expectations set out below.

Role of the School

We will:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum taking account of individual needs and enabling all children to achieve their full potential
- Teach and model the key school values listed on the school website
- Speak to all parents with dignity and respect, raise concerns in the appropriate manner without children being present and respect confidentiality
- Provide a behaviour policy to be operated consistently and fairly throughout the school
- Keep the family informed through a variety of means of their child's progress and discuss promptly any areas of concern with sensitivity and discretion
- Provide a safe and stimulating environment where children look forward to coming to school
- Encourage family involvement in school activities

Role of the Parents

We/I will:

- Help learning by supporting the school's policies and effort to ensure that my child/ren achieves their full potential
- Ensure that my child/ren attends school regularly and punctually
- Request permission from the Headteacher for all absences and illness followed up by a written letter
- Speak to all school staff with dignity and respect, raise concerns in the appropriate manner without children being present and respect confidentiality. We/I will follow school procedure i.e. Class Teacher first, a member of the Senior Leadership Team then Headteacher
- Support the school's policies and procedures particularly on behaviour and uniform regulations and promote the school positively within the community and on any social media platforms
- Keep up with payments e.g. event and lunch money, including residential trips and not fall in to arrears
- Support school events, such as fundraising activities and those which support learning with my child/ren
- Be prepared to discuss with the school any areas of concern relating to behaviour and learning with sensitivity and discretion
- Let the school know promptly of any concerns or changes in circumstances that may affect my child's learning or behaviour
- Ensure that the school has an up-to-date point of contact in case of illness or other emergency
- Read and act upon information sent from the school i.e. newsletter, other emails, app notifications, posters around school etc.

- Enter school with a growth mindset about my learning and always try to do my best in line with our school motto – *Per conatum ad astra* (Through endeavour to the stars)
- Enjoy learning and have respect for the school code of conduct
